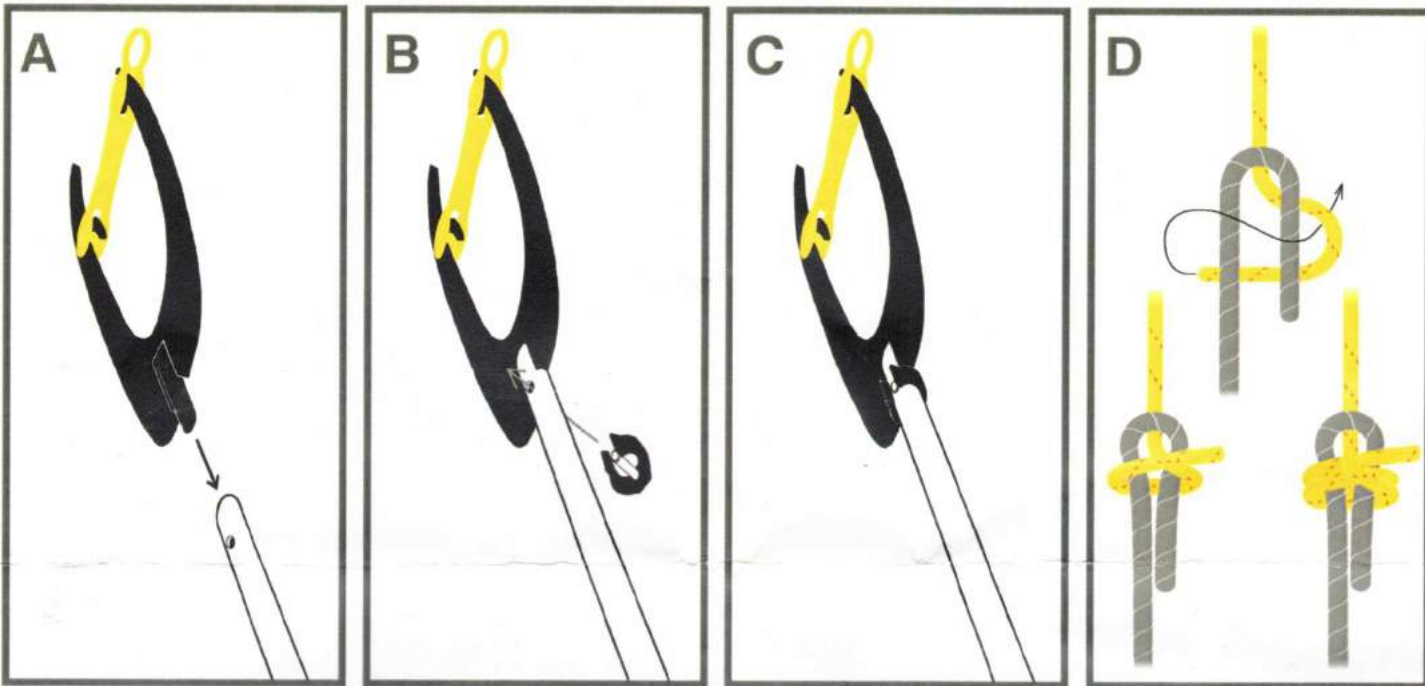


Assembly Instructions

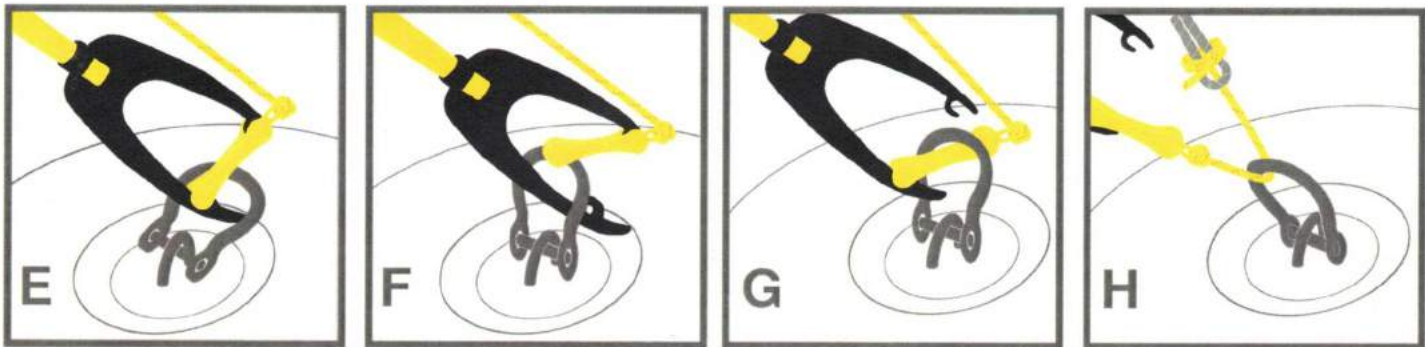
Moor Fast is a complete, ready to use mooring system. With it, you can thread a rope through a ring or around a bar or cleat and bring it back on board from the safety of your own deck.

We hope you are delighted with your Moor Fast and that you will find it a quick, safe and secure means of mooring almost anywhere. Moor Fast is manufactured from high quality materials and built to last in a marine environment. The design has been tried and tested in practice by boat owners worldwide. Your Moor Fast comes with a lifetime guarantee against breakage in normal mooring use.



Assembly simply involves attaching the Moor Fast head onto the pole and clipping the retainer ring into place as shown in Figures A, B & C.

Moor Fast works by threading its feeder line first, and using it to bring your own rope through or around the mooring. Attach your rope to the end of the Moor Fast feeder line with a sheet bend or double sheet bend knot as shown in Figure D above.



With the feeder line attached you are ready to use the Moor Fast.

- Approach the mooring, using the unique claw shaped head to scoop up rings or shackles if necessary (Figure E)
- Next, push the yellow gate against the mooring so that it opens (Figure F)
- Once the gate closes around the mooring, pull the Moor Fast back and the gate will open on the other side in order to thread the feeder line through (Figure G)
- Continue to pull to allow the feeder line to draw your rope through the mooring and back to your hand (Figure H)
